

SLG has worked with schools in California, Tennessee, New Jersey, and even schools across international borders such as Jakarta International School of Indonesia to design 10-15 days trips based off of SLG's rich experiences organizing its summer camp programs. SLG takes into account each school's available days for travel, their preferred cities to visit and the allocated budget to build the most customizable experience. "I think the most impressive thing was seeing our seventh grade students speaking in Mandarin every single day," said Liz Paz-Rumore, Director of Student Affairs at Quarry Lane School. "They really seemed to reach out to try to understand the amazing history, beauty and nuances of the culture around them. In return, everyone we encountered was very welcoming, warm and friendly."

Not only are students there to practice their Mandarin or learn about Chinese culture, but they are able to interact and participate with the locals through volunteer work, school visits, exchange activities or even shadowing a local student to experience the average day of a Chinese student.

After such an immersive cultural journey, 80% of participants said that their Chinese improved during the trip. Although a much shorter trip in comparison to SLG's core summer camp program, the SLG-customized school trips turned out to be more than what most students expected. With the vast amount of learning to be done in China, they will have to wait for their next trip to China to explore more of the fascinating cultural experiences China has to offer.




